



Frequently Asked (Phubby) Q's

Does the Phubby hold any sized cell phone?

Any cell phone, MP3 player or PDA such as a Blackberry will fit into a Phubby. But the big and fat versions of these devices are not well suited for a Phubby. Generally devices wider than 2 ¼ inches or fatter than ¾ inch aren't that comfortable. We suggest selling the phone since the experience of wearing a Phubby is so compelling.

Can I wash the Phubby?

Sure. Put it in the next load of laundry. But like socks, a Phubby is pretty small so they can mysteriously be difficult to find after the spin cycle.

Should I worry about which size Phubby to buy?

Size does matter since the human wrist comes in all diameters. We recommend carefully reviewing our sizing instructions and don't be tempted to choose a larger size.

Where did name Phubby come from?

We weren't on a drinking binge. But when we kept talking about the need for a phone cubby on one's wrist, somehow the word Phubby just became the name.

What about using the Phubby to hold something other than a cell-phone?

A Phubby makes a great place to stash keys, money, credit card, iPod, etc. In fact, there are 2 separate pockets for stuff.

Am I doing something wrong? I'm finding it a little awkward to get the phone in and out of the Phubby.

Did you read the wearing instructions? After 1,000's of hours of field testing and laboratory research, legions of Phubby users have a preference. If you are a righty, wear it on the right hand. Lefty's of course are left-handed Phubby wearers. And follow the klutz instructions or watch the web site demo to learn how to best slip the phone in and out. It is really quite easy. Only it's not so obvious. You should also rotate the phone on the wrist to the most comfortable spot although most of us prefer the inside position.
